8. FFA Roster Lookup - Search for membership numbers

Purpose: To help research or view your students' current, past or even duplicate FFA IDs to help with the Membership Check portion of related FFA award applications (American & Proficiency Awards).

Step 1: Access AET's FFA Roster Look Up

- In AET, choose the ACCOUNTS menu in Teacher section of AET
- Select "#8. FFA Roster Look Up"

Step 2: Use the Filter Options (example table below)

- You have several search options (use different ones to view different results):
 - Choose "year" to view the correct history (All is good choice)
 - Search "by FFA ID" to view the history of a specific FFA ID#...or
 - Search "by Name" (first or last) to check spelling related to an FFA ID#...or
 - \circ Search "by Chapter ID", but initially set for your program



Potential uses are:

- View incorrect spellings or duplicate FFA ID#s
- View process of submission (to state or national...checkmarks show the process)
 - View "Membership Check" used in FFA Award Applications (student award)
 - If student has the history, but combined into several FFA ID#s you can assist the student in combining those FFA ID#s into related award applications (American & Proficiency):
