Scholarship Hunt Challenge : Students explore the internet to find 2-career related scholarships and save documentation to apply. As they enter their record, they can upload documentation as part of their record.	Apply for Financial Aid/Scholarship FND.A3.06 - Personal Fin. Mgmt
Career Fair Roleplay : Host a classroom "mini-career fair" with stations from different AFNR pathways, with upperclassmen serving as employers.	Attend a Career Fair CRP.04.03 - Career Exploration

Use O*Net for Career Exploration - Career Worksheet: Assign students to use their AET Profile and "Explore More" to choose O*Net (US Department of Labor) and find a career area and report results. Employability Skills Stations : Practice introductions, teamwork, punctuality, and problem-solving in ag scenarios.	
Short Ag Advocacy Speeches: Deliver a 1-minute speech on why ag matters. Upload video/script in AET.	Explore Employment Skills CRP.01.01, CRP.04.01 , CRP.06.01, CRP.08.01 CRP.12.01 FND.A2.01 - Career Exploration
Ag Innovation Brainstorm: Work in pairs to solve a real-world ag issue (e.g., conserve water). Record process and solution in AET.	
Perspective Mapping: Debate pros and cons of ag tech (e.g., drone use, antibiotic use, agricultural lands zoning, etc). Summarize in AET Journal.	
Team Ag Challenge: Build a model farm layout as a team. Record teamwork skills in AET Journal.	
Career Salary Match: Guess and compare ag career salaries using O*Net. Record findings in AET > Career Plan and reflect on budget impact.	Explore Salaries in Career Areas <i>FND.A3.02</i>

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Mock Interview Rotation: Take turns as interviewer/interviewee using ag-specific questions.	Go to an Interview CRP.04.01
Career Fit Match: Use AET Profile to match interests with ag jobs. Record top career choices in Journal with reasoning.	
Career Speaker Series: Prepare 3 questions and take notes from a guest speaker.	Guest Speaker in Class CRP.10.03, FND.A1.01
Ag Career Match: Explore careers based on personal interests (e.g., vet tech for animal lovers).	
CDE Preview: Pick a CDE, research how to participate, and create a preparation and develop and outline of your plan, then journal in AET.	Involvement in other Career Activities <i>CS.05.01, FND.A1.01</i>
Ag Issues Roundtable: Research a current ag issue (e.g., drought effects) and lead class discussion. Record in AET Journal > Career Exploration.	Lean about Agriculture <i>CS.01.01</i>
Career Budget Plan: Use a sample ag salary to create a monthly budget. Upload budget and reflection in AET Foundational Journal > Personal Finance.	Learn about Personal Financial Management <i>CRP.03.01</i>
Safety Walkthrough: Inspect shop/greenhouse for hazards. Create and upload a safety poster or checklist in AET	Learn about Safety in the Workplace <i>CS.03.01, FND.A4.01</i>
Safety Rule Builder: List top 5 shop or livestock safety rules. Record list in AET Journal > Ag Skills.	
Informational Interview: Contact an ag professional and learn about their job. Record insights and attach notes in AET Foundational Journal.	Meet with Others to Learn about a Career <i>CRP.10.03</i>
(Similar to "Go to an Interview" above, but focused on formal practice.) Interview Roundtable: Conduct peer interviews focusing on body language and answers. Log strengths and growth in AET Foundational Journal	Participate in a Mock Interview CRP.04.01, CRP.10.01
Career Skills Match: Pick ag jobs based on your skills (e.g., scientist, researcher). Record choices and reflections in AET Journal.	
Ag Business Tour: Visit a local site (e.g., feed mill), observe workplace skills, and reflect in AET Foundational Journal.	Participate in a Workplace Tour <i>FND.A2.01, FND.A2.03</i>
Career Mentor Visit: Meet with someone in ag and ask about their path.	
Resume Builder: Create your resume in AET. Log updates, feedback, or reflections.	Work on my Resume FND.A2.02
