1. Ad in local paper, printing a flyer, and social media cost
2. Herbicides or insecticides in crop production
3. Fees paid when selling items
4. Livestock feed, usually tracked in lbs. fed
5. Nitrogen or lime to increase plant growth
6. Cost to transport SAE-related items
7. Crop or livestock insurance to cover potential losses
8. Livestock purchased for resale or moved to a new use
9. Areas not listed
10. Rental of barn or pasture space
11. Lawn mower or barn repairs to improve your assets
12. Seeds to plant a garden
13. Store crops to sell later
14. Cost to license a livestock trailer
15. Vaccinations for your animal
